Clydesdale West Policing Plan.

We recently carried out a consultation exercise in your area to discover what local concerns were, and the issues you want your Community Policing Team to deal with in the coming year.

Working in conjunction with the local community and our partners, we aim to reduce the fear of crime and increase the feeling of safety in your area. By working together, we can build safer communities.

The policing plan sets out how we plan to deal with your priorities.

Local Priorities

You identified that the policing priorities for Clydesdale West area were:

1. Drunk or Disorderly Behaviour

You told us of the problems of drunk and disorderly behaviour, youth disorder, and acts of vandalism and graffiti.

2. Drug Use and Drug Dealing

You told us there were problems of drug use and drug dealing in your area.

3. Assault and Violent Crime

You told us of your concerns regarding the level of violent crime and your concerns regarding fear of assaults within town centres.

We've listened to your concerns and you'll hopefully have seen improvements in Clydesdale West area.



Actions carried out to date.

- We have acted on intelligence in relation to persons involved in drug misuse and drug dealing, and targeted premises identified.
- We have continued to work in partnership with local housing and community wardens to identify locations where disorder and vandalism exist.
- We have increased the number of community police officers in the area, providing foot and cycle patrols.
- We have targeted and disrupted the sale of alcohol to young persons.
- We are working closely with our Partners to make long-term, achievable and sustainable improvements in your area.

In the coming months you can expect to see a number of other things happening:

- We will continue to act on intelligence in relation to persons involved in drug misuse and drug dealing.
- We will continue to work along with local housing and community wardens to reduce the incidence of vandalism and antisocial behaviour.
- We will continue to target and disrupt the sale of alcohol to young persons.
- We will continue to work closely with our Partners to solve the problems in your area.
